As CEO, John Rhind provides vision and leadership for Energy Safety Canada, a merger of Enform Canada and the Oil Sands Safety Association (OSSA).

With more than 30 years of experience in the oil and gas industry, John has held a variety of successive senior leadership roles primarily focused on oil sands operations.

John retired from Shell Canada in 2015. As the CEO for Albian Sands Energy, John was responsible for integrating Albian into Shell Canada. In his most recent role at Shell, he led the Athabasca Oil Sands Project during which time he provided strategic direction for Shell's research and development activities. As part of that portfolio, John was actively engaged in regulatory and government affairs. His work involved bridging provincial and Canadian governments at all levels, including regulators and industry to develop critical policies.

John was a member of a small group of senior executives from across the globe accountable for improving Shell's upstream asset reliability system. He was a member of the Shell Canada Board and Country Management Team, leading several initiatives for advancing workplace culture, diversity strategies, aboriginal relations and inclusion strategies for Canada.

John has close ties to Fort McMurray, having raised his family in the community. His community involvement has included serving on the Boards of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA) and the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers (CAPP).
